Who Can Enroll?

Part One: Sessions 1 - 4 are recommended for Attending Practitioners, Medical Directors and LTC Physicians.

Part Two: Sessions 5 - 8 are designed for Medical Directors and LTC Physicians who may move into this role.

You must be a current member of OLTCC to register for Part One and/or Part Two. The Medical Director Course includes both Part One and Part Two, a total of 8 sessions.

Course Questions

1. Can I take only some sessions?

You cannot select certain sessions to take. You can enroll in only Part One, Sessions 1-4, which focuses on material relevant to both Attending Practitioners and Medical Directors. Part Two, Sessions 5-8 are for Medical Directors.

- 2. Do I have to be a member of OLTCC

- 3. If I miss a session, what do I do?
 - Only credits for the sessions attended will be provided.
- **4. Is there a refund for sessions I miss or cannot attend?** *No, there are no refunds for missed or unattended sessions.*
- 5. Should I enroll for both the Medical Director Course and the Fundamentals of LTC Practice?

Who Can Enroll?

All current members of the Ontario Long Term Care Clinicians can enroll.

Format

Chapters are posted in the members only section of the Ontario Long Term Care Clinician's website. From April 28, 2021 to June 16, 2021 Chapters can be read anytime.

After each week a short post-course survey will be emailed to participants for completion. This survey is required in order to obtain your credits.

Course Questions


