Who Can Enroll?

Part One: The first four sessions is recommended for Attending Practitioners, Medical Directors and LTC Physicians. **Part Two:** The second four sessions is designed and recommended for Medical Directors and LTC Physicians. You must be a current member of OLTCC to register for Part One and/or Part Two.

Course Questions

- 1. Can I take only some sessions? You cannot select certain sessions to take. You can enroll in only Part One, Sessions 1-4, which focuses on material relevant to both Attending Practitioners and Medical Directors. Part Two, Sessions 5-8 are for Medical Directors.

Who Can Enroll?

Format

Chapters will be posted in the members only section of the Ontario Long Term Care Clinician's website in 8 week sessions, beginning January 18th, 2021 and each week thereafter (except the week of February 1st) and continuing until the last week of March 16, 2021.

Course Questions

- Can I take only read some Sessions? Yes, it is up to you—you only get credits for those completed in full.
- 2. If I don't want credits, can I just read the Chapters? *Yes, you can.*
- **2. Do I have to be a member of OLTCC** *Yes, you do. To become a member go to www.oltcc.ca.*
- **3.** If I miss a sessioin what do I do? You can complete the sessions on your own time and submit the required documents upon completion up until April 30, 2021.
- **4.** Is there a cost? No, there are no costs, except your membership fee. Access to the OLTCC Medical Director Manual is a benefit of membership.

The Process

- 1. Each Session will have a manual chapters available in the members only section of the OLTCC website for review/reading two weeks prior to the session date.
- 2. Registrants will need to complete a pre-course survey, post-session evaluations and final reflective post-course survey six-weeks after course completion.
- 3. Once the chapter has been read and the survey received, one credit per topic will be issued to the attendee for each chapter completed.
- 4. To attend the virtual session, you will be provided with a Zoom link to the webinar, with instructions.
- 5. Further information on Mainpro Cert+ credits will be provided after our application for credits is approved.
- 6. Certificates of completion will be issued at the end of the Winter Term.
