MEMORANDUM TO: All Long-Term Care (LTC) Homes

SUBJECT: Resident Death Notification (RDN)

It has come to our attention that some Long-Term Care (LTC) homes staff have received direction from coroners regarding completion of the RDN that differs from the direction provided to the LTC homes through the educational sessions and supporting materials. The inconsistent information is regarding questions 2-4 that ask if dehydration, malnutrition, pressure ulcers and contractures were present at the time of death or at the time of transfer to hospital.

When completing the RDN, the answer should be 'yes' if these conditions were present at the time of death or transfer to hospital, even if the resident was receiving palliative or end-of-life care.

The analysis of the RDN data currently underway includes reviewing the effectiveness of each of the questions. This could result in changes to future versions of the form. Coroners have been reminded that, until such time, they need to comply with the standard form provided.
